DIRECTIONS

From Auckland (approx 2 hours drive):

• Head North to Whangarei on SH 1. Stay on SH 1 bypassing Whangarei town.

• You will see a turnoff on your right to the Tutukaka Coast, you can also see a golf course on ^{aa}the right there.Take that turnoff and follow the road for about 1km then straight through a ^{aa}small roundabout, another couple of hundred metres straight through the next roundabout.

• You are now leaving a Mobil petrol station on your left and heading out of the eastern suburb ^{aa}of Tikipunga. You will see a big sign directing you towards Tutukaka, Matapouri and Ngunguru.

• Driving time from there to Ngunguru is approximately 25 minutes.

• This is a lovely drive past orchards and stone walled paddocks. You may want to stock up on ^{aa}fresh fruit at Huanui Orchard a couple of kms down the road on your left.

• The next settlement you will get to is Ngunguru. Drive along the estuary past the shop and ^{aa}over the second one lane bridge. Immediately after the bridge is a turnoff to your left. This is ^{aa}Waiotoi Road. You are almost there!

• You go straight down Waiotoi Road, this will turn into a gravel road after about 1.5km. ^{aa}Continue on the gravel road, passing a one lane bridge, then the road will fork. Stay on the ^{aa}bottom road!

• Continue over another one lane bridge until you come to the end of the Council Maintenance ^{aa}sign and a house with a wooden fence straight head. Our private road leads you up the hill ^{aa}and past that house. You take the second drive on your left, you will see our sign Maunga Iti, ^{aa}continue up the drive to the yellow house and you have arrived.
